This YouTube video advertises the new Cyberpunk 2077 game for gaming consoles such as Xbox and PlayStation and PC. It primarily shows you the actual game play you will experience if you were to purchase the game. Accompanied by the voice over explaining the story mode and details of it being a new gaming experience for open world games, it advertises a release date and that you can pre-order the product. Although this advertisement shows close-ups of characters, and wide shots of scenes such as cars driving through a scene the majority of the advert is shown in your characters point of view. This allows their target customers to see the experience they will have, and feel they're involved with how the story pans out, this camera technique is good to get viewers invested in the game before they've even purchased it. Although this footage is just over 5 minutes long, which is seemingly long for an advertisement, you have to take into consideration how small of time this is compared to the length of the game itself. This allows the producer to take the best parts of the story line in the game and condense it to show the best bits of action and adventure you'll experience. This is a typical technique used in gaming advertisements to sell their product. At the beginning of the video it clearly shows its target audience as mature 17+ and lists why it isn't suitable for a younger audience. This is because the gaming involves blood and violence, and the scenes of nudity aren't censored in this game. The use of drugs and alcohol is also a reason to why it isn't suitable to people under age people as this could be seen as impressionable substances to children who aren't mature and of age.

Access to Higher education Photo Media (19+ Digital Arts)

This session involved a digital workshop with the intention of expanding learners understanding and application of digital manipulation tools, using industry standard software such as Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator and Indesign. Many of these learners had little prior experience using these software before enrollment and this project provides their first opportunity to experiment with slightly more challenging image manipulation. The workshops inform the learners' creative responses to an industry brief which expects learners to edit, design and prepare imagery for a variety of print and digital advertising.

The session took place in situ with students present for delivery, however, also took place via a Microsoft Teams meeting with both the screen and classroom activity shared. Students were asked to discuss their understanding of particular techniques and technical terminology in groups, this was then confirmed in the delivery of the session content and said techniques demonstrated via a Photoshop workshop. This was first demonstrated with all students observing, then with students following using provided example images and then individually without guidance using their own images. A written walkthrough of the technique was posted onto the Teams project channel with supportive examples and a recording of the session.

Students then reflected on their independent practice and produced a creative outcome which stretched and challenged their abilities using this technique, perhaps considering it's application with another previously covered technique or techniques independently researched.

Access to Higher education Photo Media (19+ Digital Arts)

Students were then asked to evidence their practice; posting their completed image to the relevant Microsoft Teams channel. This provided an archive of work for later reflection, with the following session involving an online professional critique in which they would provide peer assessment in breakout rooms via a Teams meeting.

Students were later asked to complete a short *Polly* survey providing session feedback and the opportunity to request future recaps of techniques covered in previous workshops. This supports a 'flipped classroom' approach to the following technical workshop.
